

TOWN OF DECATUR
ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING CHAPTER 11 OF SAID CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING THE REGULATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE SPEED ON TOWN ROADS.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Decatur, County of Green, State of Wisconsin, ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Chapter 11 of the Town of Decatur Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

CHAPTER 11
ORDINANCE REGULATING SPEED LIMITS ON TOWN ROADS

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

The Decatur Town Board feels it is in the best interest and safety of the Town and its citizens to regulate the speed on Town roads.

SECTION 2: STATE TRAFFIC LAWS ADOPTED

Except as otherwise specifically provided for in this Chapter, the statutory provisions in Chapters 340 – 350 of the Wisconsin State Statutes, describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this Chapter as if fully set forth herein. Any future amendments, revisions, or modifications of the statutory regulations in Chapters 340 – 350 of the Wisconsin State Statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made a part of this Chapter in order to secure to the extent legally practicable uniform statewide regulation of vehicle traffic on the highways, streets, and alleys of the State of Wisconsin.

SECTION 3: SPEED LIMITS ON SUB-DIVISION ROADS

The statutory speed limit on the following roads are unsafe and imprudent and shall be modified as follows:

The following sub-division roads shall have a speed limit of 25 miles per hour:

The following sub-division roads shall have a speed limit of 20 miles per hour:
Oak Ridge Road
Taylor Trail

SECTION 4: SPEED LIMIT ON GOLF COURSE ROAD

The statutory speed limit on Golf Course Road is unsafe and imprudent and shall be modified to 35 miles per hour for the entire length of Golf Course Road.

SECTION 5: SPEED LIMIT ON DECATUR/ALBANY ROAD

The statutory speed limit on Decatur/Albany Road is unsafe and imprudent and shall be modified to 45 miles per hour for the entire length of Decatur/Albany Road.

SECTION 6: SPEED LIMIT ON TEN EYCK ROAD

The statutory speed limit on Ten Eyck Road is unsafe and imprudent and shall be modified to 45 miles per hour for the entire length of Ten Eyck Road.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the day after passage and publication as required by law.
